EASTER TO PENTECOST— THE GREAT FIFTY DAYS



The Season of Easter lasts 50 days.

This is a reminder that in the TORAH, every fifty years, the fiftieth year would be declared "Jubilee." This meant that all debts would be forgiven and everyone in the Jew-

ish tribes could be "equal" or could "start over again." Those first Jewish Christians believed that in Christ...

God has allowed us "JUBILEE!"

All debts and sins are forgiven, and we can start equal and new again! After a period of deep connections with the risen Lord, the disciples once again felt the grief of his absence as he ascended to God. But, the Holy Spirit, promised by

Jesus, would come to remind them of why Christ came, and how they would live from that time forward. Judaism celebrated the receiving of the TORAH on Mt. Sinai fifty days after the Passover meal and exodus from Egypt. This was the celebration of *Pentecost*. The church kept the name, but understood it to mean more than receiving the Holy Law of God, but also the Holy Spirit of God.
