Overcoming Fear

God of justice and mercy, love and grace, life in shalom, we confess that we are often overcome by the loud and persistent voices of fear and anger. We do not hear the voice of Jesus, which often seems but a whisper.

Jesus said: "If you, then, as stubborn humans, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!" (Matthew 7: 11)
